### **GET INVOLVED**

We need volunteers from a variety of backgrounds and spanning the generations. Including medical professionals (doctors, dentists), pastors, ministry leaders, and others with energy and flexibility to serve!  
Our goal is for 75 people from across the US to come and serve alongside 125 NU students. We are also looking for ministry sponsors and lead or support churches.



### **ITINERARY**

Travel from the US to Zambia takes about two days (30-35 hours).  
July 6\* or 7: Arrive in Ndola; if arriving on July 6 you can attend a local church service Sunday.  
July 8: City tour and ministry project preparation with students.  
July 9-11: Full-day service at ministry project locations.  
July 12: Half-day service projects followed by community celebration.  
July 13: Return home or go to safari destinations.\*  
July 14: Safari excursions in Livingstone or South Luangwa.  
July 15: Return home, 30+ hours.

**COST** average from \$3,500 to \$5,250  
The mission trip cost is \$1,000, Air travel costs, average \$2,000  
Required travel documents/optional medical precautions, average \$500  
\*Early arrival costs, average \$250  
\*Safari excursion, averages \$1,500

### **SAFARI, VICTORIA FALLS**

Situated about six miles from the city of Livingstone is one of the world's seven natural wonders and one of the most spectacular natural sites in the world. The Falls are over a mile wide with a vertical drop of 328 feet.  
A visit to Victoria Falls includes a boat and land safari in Botswana. Here, you are likely to see zebra, elephants, giraffe, monkeys, possibly even lions and more!
